

Public Presentation: Guidelines for General Audience

Public presentations are conducted as part of the Second screening to ensure the transparency of the competition and to widely promote this initiative.

Therefore, to maintain a fair and rigorous evaluation, attendees of the public presentation are required to adhere to the following rules. Disobeying these rules may result in removal from the venue.

1. Smartphones, mobile phones, and other electronic devices must be stored in lockers or other designated areas.
2. Photography, audio recording, and communication with external parties are strictly prohibited during the presentation.
3. Please maintain silence and refrain from any actions that may disrupt the proceedings.
4. Audience members are not permitted to ask questions or make statements.
5. Expressing approval or disapproval, including clapping, is not allowed.
6. Eating and drinking inside the venue is not permitted.
7. Entry and exit during the presentation and Q&A session are not allowed.
8. Any contact with judges and presenters, including greetings, is strictly prohibited.

9. Individuals carrying knives or other dangerous objects, those under the influence of alcohol, or those who may disturb the order will not be allowed to attend.
10. Please follow any additional instructions given by the event staff.
