Public Presentation: Guidelines for General Audience

Public presentations are conducted as part of the Second screening to ensure the transparency of the competition and to widely promote this initiative.

Therefore, to maintain a fair and rigorous evaluation, attendees of the public presentation are required to adhere to the following rules. Disobeying these rules may result in removal from the venue.

- 1. Smartphones, mobile phones, and other electronic devices must be stored in lockers or other designated areas.
- 2. Photography, audio recording, and communication with external parties are strictly prohibited during the presentation.
- 3. Please maintain silence and refrain from any actions that may disrupt the proceedings.
- 4. Audience members are not permitted to ask questions or make statements.
- 5. Expressing approval or disapproval, including clapping, is not allowed.
- 6. Eating and drinking inside the venue is not permitted.
- 7. Entry and exit during the presentation and Q&A session are not allowed.
- 8. Any contact with judges and presenters, including greetings, is strictly prohibited.

- 9. Individuals carrying knives or other dangerous objects, those under the influence of alcohol, or those who may disturb the order will not be allowed to attend.
